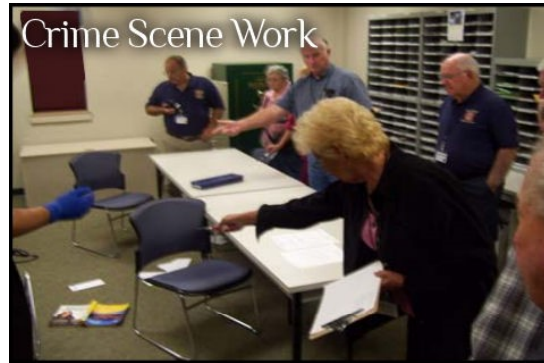
Mission Statement
