CITIZENS ACADEMY

The Brunswick County Sheriff's Office Citizens Academy was established to build a better understanding between Law Enforcement and those we serve, through a series of classroom presentations and community involvement. The academy is open to all persons over the age of 18.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The curriculum and training are not what you might expect. Typically, the students attracted to the academy are a culturally diverse group of people including bankers, businessmen and women, judges, housewives, school teachers, media representatives, retirees and citizens from all walks of life.

Participants meet ten Tuesday afternoons at the Brunswick County Sheriff's Office training room in Bolivia from 1:00pm- 4:00pm and two Saturday classes off site. They learn about virtually every aspect of a deputy's job including administration, patrol operations, traffic enforcement and communications, criminal law, SWAT and hostage negotiations, crime scene investigations, corrections and many other areas.

The Citizens Academy does not limit participants to classroom training. Students are given the opportunity to:

- * Tour the Detention facility, 911 center and Courthouse.
- * Shoot weapons at our new firearms range.
- * See our boats, helicopter and K9's in action.



Although graduates of the Citizens Academy are not qualified for daily street duty, they do acquire a better understanding of the Brunswick County Sheriff's Office operations and responsibilities.

Citizens Academy graduates gain greater awareness and appreciation of the difficult challenges and decisions a deputy sheriff faces every day.
